

The medium of instruction is English and the academic year for the School is from June to next April.

Admissions are made in Pre.K.G., L.K.G., U.K.G., Classes and from standards I to . For direct admissions children should satisfy the age rule i.e. 2+ for nursery, 3+ for L.K.G., 4+ for U.K.G., 5+ for the I Std., and so on, on or before 31st July of the year of admission. Students coming from unrecognised institutions will not be admitted. Xerox copy of the BIRTH CERTIFICATE (or) Original Copy of Transfer Certificate should be produced at the time of admission.

Parents are responsible for their wards regularity and punctuality in attending school. Minimum of 80% attendance is required for promotion to next higher class. Absent without applying for leave will be viewed seriously and punished.

Fees Payment

Payment of fees will be accepted in the School office between 9.30 a.m to 12.45 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. But on Saturday between 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. only.

Parents are requested to make all remittance of fees at the School fees counter in time and get receipts. When there is a discrepancy in the payment of fees already made, it should be get clarified by producing the relevant receipt in the School office. Fees once paid will not be refunded.

Complaints

Any communications, report or complaint of the parents / guardians should be addressed to the Principal (or) correspondent.

Parents / Guardians are not allowed to deal directly with the teachers of the school regarding any complaint.

Examination & Tests

There will be three terminal examinations conducted in a year in September, December and April in addition to the monthly tests conducted by every month from July to next February.

A pupil is promoted to the next higher class on the basis of the performance during the whole year. Hence regularity in attendance and studies is imperative.

The school will not hold any special test or examination or practicals for the absence during test and examinations.

Results once declared at the end of the year are final for all classes and will not be reconsidered under any circumstances.

Conduct, Punctuality & Discipline

Students should be punctual in attending the School. Late coming should be avoided. Irregular attendance neglect in doing homework, disobedience and disrespect towards members of the staff justify dismissal. It is compulsory for every pupil to come to school in full uniform, clean and tidy including foot wear well polished.

Pupils are not allowed to come to school with gold ornaments of any kind or any other costly wear.

Each pupil is responsible for his/her own things, Books, Note Books and other articles.

When any damage is caused to the school property by any pupil, it should be brought to the notice of the Principal immediately.

Enlisting the Students to the School implies that the parents / Guardians and students agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the School formed by the management from time to time.

Every pupil is expected to be courteous and good natured. Misbehaviour and use of foul languages, gross insubordination to school authorities and teachers will be seriously dealt with which may even lead to expulsion of the pupil concerned from the school.

Issue Of Transfer Certificate

Parents requiring Transfer Certificate have to apply atleast three days in advance with fee of Rs. 250/-

A pupil detained twice in a class in succession will be removed from the rolls and T.C. will be issued.

General Instruction

Free Medical Examinations will be conducted for the students by the school and reports will be sent to parents.

Van facility is provided for the Students from distant places.

The Management is appointing well qualified, trained and experienced Teachers to handle the classes. Monthly Progress Report will be sent to parents for their signature.

The School has got a good Library and adequate laboratory facilities for Science and Computer Science.

Physical education is given by well trained P.E.T. master.

Parents can meet the principal between 10.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. on every month at a mentioned date.

The Hand Book is a link between the parents and the School. This must be brought to School daily by the pupil. Parents are requested to checkup the hand-book daily to know about the homework, assignment etc., given by the teachers and help the wards to attend them properly in time.

Normally parents / guardians are not permitted or see their wards or interview the teachers during class hours except on unavoidable circumstances after getting permission from the Principal.

A record of address of parents / guardians is maintained in the school office. Any change in the address should be communicated to the Principal then and there.

Note To Students

Wish every teacher irrespective of the class handled. Stand up to once, wish a teacher or visitor when they enter and leave the class room.

Don't interfere when the teachers are conversing.

Be polite while speaking to teachers, elders in general. Use "Please" while requesting and "Thank" while receiving.

Maintain silence in absence of the teacher.

Talk with whispers in the class rooms and corridors and stop conversing when teachers or others superiors pass by.

Read the students hand-book carefully and act on it. Make note in it of important things to you.

Use of bad language, unruly behaviour and manners are strictly forbidden. Aim at full attendance and unfailing punctuality.

Be God Fearing. A prayer to God for help will always be answered by him.

Never waste time. Time is precious. Use it well.

Make friendship with studious companions. They will help you by work and example. Work hard and do your best in studies. Your parents and the Nation are expecting a lot from you.

Take part in games, recreation which will refresh your mind and give you new energy for study.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PUPILS

1. All must come to school on time and in full, clean and prescribed uniforms on all working days and at all school functions.
2. Should strictly follow the school timings prescribed.
3. Every one is expected to be in the school five minutes before the first bell.
4. All should take part in the Prayer and assembly without fail. After the assembly, pupils should go silently to their respective class rooms.
5. Should maintain strict discipline inside as well as outside the class rooms.
6. Are not supposed to shout or play inside the classrooms or on the corridors.
7. Should wear neat and trim uniforms on all working days. Shirts should be smartly tucked in. Boys should see that their hair is trimmed at regular intervals.
8. All home works must be completed and submitted on time without fail.
9. Are responsible for the care of personal belongings. Expensive jewels or ornaments are totally banned and the school management takes no responsibility to their loss.
10. The institution takes responsibility for the students within the school premises, but not for any outward incident which is beyond their control.
11. The students are forbidden to write or scribble on the walls, and throw paper or ink inside the class rooms and school premises. Penalty for the damage done to buildings, furnitures must be paid at the discretion of the principal.

12. The absentees for the annual examination without proper reason will be considered as detained. No re-examination will be held. In case of meritorious students, the marks of the year will be considered by the principal for promotion.
13. Parents or guardian are not allowed to interview their children or to speak to the teachers during school hours. All enquiries must be made at the school office.
14. The school accepts no responsibility if the pupil is obliged to return home during the class hours for not wearing the school uniform, for not bringing books to class, for not producing signature of the parents, on remarks written by teachers, on the absence record, in the calendar, for reason of indiscipline and for repeated late coming.
15. Fees once paid will not be refunded. Late payment may result pupils being debarred from examinations..
16. Students must bring their diary on all working days of the school.
17. Parents are requested to read the above regulations carefully and to ensure that their children abide by them.
18. Should always create a happy and healthy atmosphere in the school and try to be happy and cheerful.


